

# Facts: Your Vote Counts!

Ever think your vote doesn't count?



Consider this...

- ⇒ In 1876, **just one vote** made Rutherford B Hayes President of the US
- ⇒ In 1920, the passage of the 19<sup>th</sup> amendment which gave women won the right to vote passed by **just one vote** in Tennessee, the last state needed to pass the amendment
- ⇒ In 1960, **just one vote** per precinct elected John F Kennedy
- ⇒ In 2000, George Bush won the state of Florida and thus the presidency by just 546 votes, out of millions cast. In New Mexico he won by just 366 votes.
- ⇒ In our own state, Governor Christine Gregoire was elected in 2004 by just 129 votes, following 2 recounts
